



Norwegian EV policy

- No purchase taxes (extremely high for ordinary cars)
- Exemption from 25% VAT on purchase and leasing
- Low annual road tax
- No charges on toll roads or ferries
- Free municipal parking
- Access to bus lanes
- 50 % reduced company car tax

Models by style and range available through 2020








Figure 2: Norwegian EV fleet development. Source: Norwegian Public Roads Administration [2] and OFV AS [1].

Environmental Achievement of the Year


Environmental Achievement of the Year: POSTEN NORGE (NORWAY POST)

Posten Norge (Norway Post) set a target in 2009 to reduce its CO2 emissions by 30% by the end of 2015. The post achieved this a year ahead of schedule and the operator has now set a new target to reduce its CO2 emissions by 40% by 2020.

Colin Campbell, SVP for Environment and Social Responsibility at Posten Norge, says, "We have had six green years as a result of both small and big initiatives that have resulted in CO2 reductions, which has been great. One of the main initiatives that has helped us achieve this target has been investment in our electric fleet."

Posten Norge currently has the largest electric fleet in Norway, with more than 1,100 zero-emissions vehicles. The latest addition to this fleet was made in June 2015, when the post announced that it had purchased 300 electric cars. This acquisition is part of the post's largest investment in CO2 reduction. The new cars will be fully operational by 2016. "The removal of fossil-fueled vehicles has and will continue to be a major part of our strategy," Campbell adds.














Smart engine turns any bike electric


