

- ▶ Die 5. grösste in Norwegen
- ▶ Unter den am schnellsten wachsenden Kommunen.
- ▶ 12.500 Angestellte.
- ▶ Budget 2018-2021
 - ▶ Jahresumsatz 1 Mrd Euro
 - ▶ Jährliche Investitionen 220 – 260 Mio. Euro



■ Betreuung im Heim




Die Bevölkerung wächst also um etwa 40%, aber der Bedarf an Arbeitskraft um 75%.....

- ▶ You should always and easily be able to find out what the public sector knows about you, and who has seen this information.





ONE Bærum – digital first choice



Climate strategy 2030

- ▶ Bærum municipality:
«Klimaklug» by 2020
- ▶ Bærum shall become a low-emission society by 2050 and reduce the CO₂-emissions with 40% by 2030
- ▶ In 2027 Fornebu has been established as a zero-emission area



Mobilising for a Climate smart municipality


- *Main strategies*


Mobility

- ▶ In 2025 25% of privately owned cars in Bærum are zero emission cars.
- ▶ In 2025 the share of person travels by public transportation, bike or walked within Bærum should be 60%, by bike alone 7%.
For the municipal employees – the goals should be reached by 2020.
- ▶ In 2025 all use of passenger cars in municipal service should be zero emission vehicles and all larger vehicles fueled fossil free.




Municipal properties

- ▶ Municipal buildings (schools, kindergardens etc.), as well as houses and commercial properties should be area- and energy efficient and make use of sustainable and future oriented energy solutions as well as climate friendly building materials
- ▶ In 2020 the energy consumption in municipal buildings has been reduced by 12 percent compared to 2016.



Climate smart municipality

- ▶ Inhabitants choosing solutions which are resource efficient and climate friendly
- ▶ Businesses creating growth and new workplaces from climate friendly products and services
- ▶ A public and private sector requesting climate friendly solutions and facilitating the transformation
